

Age of Steam Roundhouse Job Description

Position Description: Machinist
Reports to: Chief Mechanical Officer
FSLA Status: Full Time; Non-Exempt
Salary: Commensurate with experience

Under the direction of the Chief Mechanical Officer, the Machinist will perform duties related to the restoration of the Age of Steam Roundhouse's collection.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Sets up, adjusts, or operates basic or specialized machine tools used to perform precision machining operations.
- Aligns and secures holding fixtures, cutting tools, attachments, accessories, or materials onto machines.
- Must be able to read blueprints, understand and use various measuring devices.
- Measures, examines, or tests completed units to check for defects and ensure conformance to specifications, using precision instruments, such as micrometers.
- Maintains machine tools in proper operational condition.
- Tracks machine tool inventory and places requests to purchase new tooling.
- Checks work pieces to ensure that they are properly lubricated or cooled.
- Diagnoses machine tool malfunctions to determine need for adjustments or repairs.
- Lays out, measures, and marks metal stock to display placement of cuts.
- Fits and assembles parts to make or repair machine tools.
- Sets up or operates metalworking, brazing, heat-treating, welding, or cutting equipment.
- Disposes of scrap or waste material in accordance with company policies and environmental regulations.
- Evaluates machining procedures and recommends changes or modifications for improved efficiency or adaptability.
- Dismantles machines or equipment, using hand tools or power tools to examine parts for defects and replace defective parts where needed.
- Perform other duties as required.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Minimum of 2 years experience with manually operated machine tools.
- Must possess general mechanical skills.
- Must possess a valid driver's license for the State of Ohio.
- Must be able to lift 60 pounds and work on ladders and scaffolds.
- Basic knowledge and skills in railroad track repairs and electric welding, cutting, heating, and brazing torch skills.
- Basic knowledge of maintenance and operation of steam locomotives, diesel and/or electric locomotives, passenger and freight cars.
- Basic understanding of Federal Railroad Administration rules and regulations.
